

# Chinese Government Scholarship Application Notice

Education Office, Consulate-General of The People's Republic of China in Sydney

In order to promote the mutual understanding, cooperation and exchanges in various fields between China and other countries, the Chinese government has set up a series of scholarship programs to sponsor international students, teachers and scholars to study and conduct research in Chinese universities.

Now, about 300 designated Chinese universities offer a wide variety of academic programs in science, engineering, agriculture, medicine, economics, legal studies, management, education, history, literature, philosophy, and arts for scholarship recipients at all levels.

## I Eligibility

1. Applicants must be a citizen of a country other than the People's Republic of China, and be in good health.
2. When applying for a discipline or specialty with Chinese as the professional language of instruction, bachelor degree applicants, general scholars (except those majoring in Chinese language) or senior scholars should reach the third level of HSK in principle, and master degree or doctoral degree applicants should reach the fourth level of HSK in principle.
3. The requirements for applicants' degree and age are that applicants must:  
be a high school graduate under the age of 25 when applying for the undergraduate programs;  
be a bachelor degree holder under the age of 35 when applying for the master's programs;  
be a master degree holder under the age of 40 when applying for the doctoral programs;  
be under the age of 45 and have a high school diploma (or higher) when applying for the general scholar programs;  
be a master degree holder or an associate professor (or above) under the age of 50 when applying for the senior scholar programs.
4. To apply for undergraduate major in economics and management, one should have

corresponding basic knowledge of mathematics; to major in science and engineering, one should have corresponding basic knowledge of mathematics, physics and chemistry; to major in medicine, one should have corresponding basic knowledge of mathematics, physics, chemistry or biology. To apply for a postgraduate major, one should have relevant academic background.

5. Applicants are suggested to contact the international admission office of the target university in advance to obtain the pre-admission letter. This will help increase chances of getting the scholarship.

6. Each scholarship recipient will be allowed to be on no more than one scholarship granted by either Chinese government or his/her host institution. Otherwise, they will be disqualified from the Chinese Government Scholarship and asked to return the scholarship they have received. In addition, those who deliberately conceal other financial assistance shall not be allowed to apply for Chinese Government Scholarship in the next three years.

Please refer to the attachment for the operation method and required materials. We do not require applicants to provide hard copies, nor do we accept hard copies.

## **III Application Deadline**

Applicants are requested to submit their applications through the system before **February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020**. Education Office, Consulate-General of The People's Republic of China in Sydney will complete the acceptance, examination and submission of the applications before February 21<sup>th</sup>, 2020.
